Knitting Classes

Knitting Group Friday Mornings

This is a knitting group/class where anyone can come along with their knitting project to receive guidance and tuition as they create an article of their choice. These sessions will be most suited for beginners to intermediate level however, all skill levels are most welcome. Both knitting and crocheted projects can be completed.

Now running 4 terms per year Friday Mornings 9.30am – 12.30pm

TERM 2 = May 3rd, 10th, 17th, 24th, 31st, June 7th, 14th, 21st, 28th

TERM 3 = July 26th, August 2nd, 9th, 16th, 23rd, 30th, September 6th, 13th, 20th

TERM 4 = October 18th, 25th, November 1st, 8th, 15th, 22nd, 29th, December 6th, 13th

You will be required to supply your own yarn, pattern and supplies for your chosen project.

You may book up front for the whole 9 weeks and pay only \$45 OR \$6 per session (as you attend)



Patchwork Classes

General Patchwork Classes

Running over two terms

Choose your own project/s and receive help from a staff member experienced in quilting and patchwork at each step as required. Work alongside like-minded people and enjoy the buzz of a group atmosphere.

This is run to coincide with the school term over the winter months of term 2 and term 3 and is 8 weeks in duration.

TERM 3 = July 25th, August 1st, 8th, 15th, 22nd, 29th, September 5th, 12th

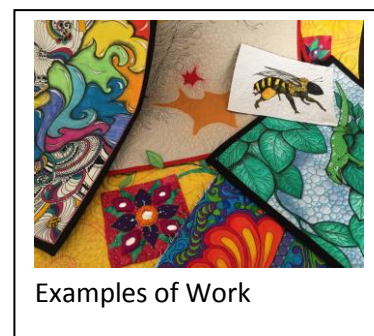
Please book upfront as this will be strictly limited to 8 people.

Art Quilts Your Way

Over Two Days

What is an art quilt and why would I want to make one? “I have a great idea, but I have no idea how to do it”. “I can’t draw, so art quilts aren’t for me”. Have you had these thoughts? Learn various methods to express yourself through quilting. You will explore different ways to get what is in your head into your hands and onto/in fabrics. You will investigate various platforms and artists for inspiration, and then investigate how we can create our vision. Creative piecing? Applique? Paint? Collage? Photo on fabric? Wholecloth? Big Stitch? There are endless ways



to get from point A to point B and none of them are wrong. Several small trial pieces will be created during class.

Dressmaking Classes

General Dressmaking Classes

Held over 4 Terms

These classes consist of an 8 week term (working roughly with the school terms). They are held on either Tuesday evenings, Wednesday Mornings, Wednesday Evenings or Saturday Mornings.

You get to choose the project of your choice, this could be a garment for yourself, for someone else, an accessory (such as a bag), alteration work and more.

Please ask for the dressmaking timetable to view all the dates/times.

Class Fee = \$130 PER TERM + materials/supplies will be required. Tutor = Raewyn Payne

DAY Tuesday October 1st 9.30am – 1.30pm

Cushion with book pocket and handle

This handy cushion can be taken on car trips or holidays. It doubles up as a carry bag for your favourite book or notepad as well as a soft cushion to relax with. A zipper is placed into the back of the cushion making it easy to add the cushion inner or remove when the outer cushion needs washing.

Elasticated Shorts

This class is suitable for those who already have confident machine skills.
There will be different sized patterns to suit with an easy to adjust elastic waist.

Fabric book cover and book marker/pen holder

Choose your favourite fabric or select one that you can colour in later! The handy fabric book marker has a pocket for your pen, keeping everything nicely together.

Crazy Cat Patchwork Mat

This class involves foundation piecing – a piece of calico with the pattern lines drawn onto it, giving you a line to stitch over.

The supplies for this class will be precut and provided in a kit*.

***Please note the fabric will vary from the picture attached.**

Prior sewing machine experience is a must for this class.



Class Fee = \$15 + **\$18 for the kit.**

Drawstring backpack
