Would you like to learn more about your machine and expand your sewing knowledge whilst getting together with inspirational crafty people?

WHEN: Bi-monthly – first Saturday of the month
February 1st, April 4th, June 6th, August 1st, October 3rd, December 5th

TIME: Saturday 2pm - 4pm

WHERE: Classroom, at the shop

COST: \$2 per session

FORMAT: The first part of the session will include a talk and demonstration/s that will differ each time and may showcase a foot/accessory for the machine or overlocker, needles, threads, craft, patchwork or dressmaking techniques. Often everything revolves around a common theme, with an inspirational display area.

The sessions are usually demonstrative only, so unlike a class, you do not need to bring your machine along.

The second part of the session is when members bring along items for our 'show and tell'. We set a theme prior to make it easier and give ideas of what to bring.

AIM: To learn more about your machines, so you may be able to take your sewing to the next level. To share and inspire each other with ideas, stories and sewing projects.

NEWSLETTERS: Newsletters will be issued on a regular basis at least two weeks before each session to inform you of the project and allow for you to let us know whether you would like to attend in order to have enough project/design material on hand for that particular session. Newsletters can be emailed or sent via post (although email is preferred)
